


Accompaniment in the preparation of requests to the CRG SI Short-Term Technical Assistance Program

- 12 countries and a network were accompanied (Belize, Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Guyana, Haiti, Peru, Suriname and Venezuela; & LANPUD).
- 5 applications approved to date (Colombia, Ecuador, El Salvador, Suriame, LANPUD).
- 5 applications still in progress (Belize, Bolivia, Guyana, Haiti and Venezuela).
- 2 applications returned for rescheduling or adjustment (Guatemala and Peru).
- Topics: social contracting, transition and sustainability (Belize and Ecuador); strengthening the movement of sex workers (Bolivia); system of election of community representatives of the CCM of Colombia; responses to TRP (El Salvador and Suriname), strengthening community response to TB (Peru), stigma and discrimination (Haiti); improvement of the understanding of the financing model of the Global Fund (Venezuela); CLM & C19RM (Guatemala).
- 2 requests with direct support from the LAC Platform to improve community participation in funding requests from Peru and Honduras.

C19RM 2021

- **17 countries** and a **multi-country project** were supported to organize consultations to identify community priorities for C19RM 2021.
- 9 countries directly supported by the LAC Platform and other partners (SES, W4GF, Mpact, NSWP): Belize, Bolivia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guyana, Panama, Paraguay and Peru
- 7 countries and the multi-country HIV ALEP&KP project received TA from ICASO through the TA Program: Colombia, Guatemala, Honduras, Jamaica, Nicaragua, Suriname, Venezuela.
- Dominican Republic received support through W4GF.
- In total, 810 members of the HIV, TB, Malaria communities and key populations from the **18** countries and the multi-country project were consulted.
- Development of a tool to carry out social dialogues to identify needs.
- Developed a specific communication strategy to disseminate key information through all available channels of the LAC Platform.
- Elaboration of a case study to document lessons learned, main priorities identified, challenges and recommendations.





2021 Opportunities and Challeges

- C19RM 2021 was a great opportunity to provide support to the communities. Sufficient time is needed to plan better.
- It is necessary to strengthen understanding on the CRG SI Short Term TAP Progame among communities to generate more targeted and effective demand.
- Communications are being strengthening with the collaboration of key partners such as PANCAP, Key Correspondents and Partners in Health (Socios en Salud).
- The LAC Platform has a total budget for the 2021-2023 period of \$ 625,000 USD.
 In 2021 we have executed a total of \$ 150,000 USD. Additionally, \$ 61,000 USD was invested in the tasks of C19RM 2021. The technical team is made up of 9 people. They include a technical coordinator, 4 professionals are in charge of the communications area; 3 professionals provide technical support to the subregions and a head of administration.





Activities for 2022

- Launch of the virtual map and its first up-date.
- Webinars and Capacity Building: LANPUD, Venezuelan Diaspora, Global Fund Financing Model, CRG SI Short-Term TA Program, Safety & Security, Community Led Monitoring, CCM Evolution.
- Case studies on the community response to HIV, TB and malaria (Central America, South America and the Caribbean)
- Analysis of the quality of TA services and opportunities to improve the generation of demand and the provision of TA by providers.
- Face to face Sub-Regional meetings in Central & South America and The Caribbean.
- Continue: Communications and accompaniment of TA request to the CRG SI Short Term TA Program.
