Proposed Purpose

A Monitoring and Oversight Tool is being developed to facilitate the process in which Civil Society Organization's (CSO's)/Community Based Organization's (CBO's) and communities can fulfil their important role of ensuring that the communities most affected are being impacted by Global Fund Processes

- Equipping communities with the necessary information and guidance
 - Hold decision makers accountable
 - Ensure meaningful engagement of key and vulnerable populations



Audience

The primary audience for this tool will be:

- CSO's / CBO's and communities , with special focus on key populations

This tool will include

- lessons learnt,
- will serve to inform CCM's, stakeholders and other key decision makers in the disease response, and
- how engage civil society partners and communities in all Global Fund processes throughout the grant cycle, but most importantly,
- in their monitoring and oversight role.



HOW TO USE THIS TOOL

This tool will seek to increase awareness and knowledge on the Global Fund including the important role that communities should play throughout all its processes in particular the role of monitoring and oversight.

The tool will comprise of 4 sections:

- 1.) Global Fund Basics;
- 2.) The Global Fund Sustainability, Transition and Co-Financing Policy;
- 3.) Key Partnerships in the Process,
- 4.) Technical Assistance for Civil Society Organizations.



The Outcome

The expectation is that CSOs/CBO's and communities will be able to use the tool as an organizational and personal resource document, but also as a source of information for training sessions for their constituencies where necessary and possible.
